

Here are some Questions you might have. I have answers!

I was receiving the links to the online classes, but am no longer. How do I get the links?

Last week, all of the FBC dancers received the links to the online classes for no charge as everyone paid for their April tuition. In order to continue to pay our teachers and keep FBC running until we can get back into the classroom, we are now moving to an online subscription. Check out the website at fredericksburgballet.com to learn how you can start subscribing.

We were unable to take classes last week. Can I try a class before deciding to subscribe?

YES. Go to our website at fredericksburgballet.com and look at the schedule. Email me which class your child would like to try and I will send you that link.

What if we don't/can't take the online classes? Will we be able to return to classes once FBC opens again?

YES!! This is our temporary solution for the situation the world has found itself in. Our goal is to return to business as usual when it is safe.

My child is in the BEG category, but would like to take a JR class. Can she?

No. Students in a lower level will not be admitted. This is mainly because we do not see the dancers for the whole class and our teachers will be unable to help your children with correct placement. We are only doing video for students back to teachers sparingly during class for feedback. If we have our students stay in their respective levels they will continue to work on movements they know and will not be at danger of hurting themselves.

My child is in the Jr level but has never taken Tap/Jazz/Ballet/HipHop/Musical Theater/Lyrical before. Can she level down and take the CM/BEG class? Absolutely! What a great time to try something new.

My child only took 1 class a week at FBC. Can they take Ballet/Jazz/Tap/HipHop class?

YES. Not only that, they can take the Saturday morning Wild Card Class. To find out what level you should take, check out the schedule for full listing of the categories. But if you only want to take one class a week, then that is fine too.

Will the schedule remain the same? I don't see my teacher listed.

My intention is to keep the classes the same each week and have different teachers teaching some of the classes. This all depends upon teacher availability. Each week, a new schedule will be posted so you can plan ahead. All the teachers at FBC are professional, qualified and pretty spectacular!

How long are the classes?

We are aiming around 45 minutes to an hour. The JR & SR Ballet classes are 1.5 hours.

I have 2 kids that need to take different classes at the same time. How do I do that?

Put them in separate rooms on separate devices. You don't need a full zoom account to view a class just the meeting number and password. You can run the zoom app on a phone without a login.

Do we have to enable the video feature?

When you first come online, your audio & video will be off. Sometimes the teachers will ask to spotlight a student or ask if you would like to put your video on to "show" their dance, but you do not have to.
